
What is the Process to become an NMB Church Planter or Redevelopment Pastor?

- 1) Send your resume and a completed initial assessment questionnaire to the NMB Director's office. An interactive assessment questionnaire is also available online at www.nationalmissionboard.com
- 2) A personal interview will be set up with several members of the NMB.
- 3) An initial assessment interview will be set up with our in-house assessment team. Interview will be based on the initial assessment questionnaire.
- 4) Upon approval, an interview will be set up with the Primitive Methodist School of Theology. This interview will be to determine theological compatibility with our doctrinal beliefs and also to explain educational requirements necessary for ordination.
- 5) A full and complete assessment will be conducted using an outside agency.
- 6) After reviewing feedback from all interviews and assessments, the NMB will determine a ministry plan of action.
